

How much does God really love us?

Most of us are aware of the remarkable statement by Jesus, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16.)

He describes Jesus as His beloved Son.

And that is how God loves us when we submit to Him and follow Jesus.

What a tremendous revelation!

If we know that somebody really loves us we have no hesitation in asking them for help and approaching them for various reasons.

Now we know that God loves us just as He loved Jesus Christ and we can come boldly to the throne of Grace knowing that God loves us and will listen to us.

This increases our faith enormously. Our prayers will not go unanswered. God is listening to us His beloved children.

"For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him." (2 Chronicles 16:9.)

If we are true followers of Jesus Christ, God is constantly watching us. He loves us as He loves Jesus. He is listening to us.

"Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him." (1 John 5:14-15.)

As I have loved my own sons and listened to them and their requests, so I know that God listens to me and my requests.

This gives me tremendous confidence to minister in the power of the Holy Spirit, to believe for miracles in my own life and those of others and most of all to see many people come to Christ.
