We read the Word of God daily and therefore do not forget it. Every day God spoke to us through His word. As we read that Word thoughts would come to us and as we shared them with each other we found that the Holy Spirit was in our midst.

As we look into the law of liberty, which begins at the new birth and continues every day as we pray to God and read his word, then powerful events happened in our lives.

God directs us very clearly through these events and sometimes disciplines us through them by making us realise we are on the wrong course.
